PROCEDURE DETAILS:

All applicants are required to indicate a felony conviction on the Goodwin University application for admission. If an applicant indicates "Yes" to having a felony conviction, the Admissions Officer asks if the conviction led to the applicant being placed on the CT State Registry for Sex Offenders. If the applicants responds affirmatively, the Admissions Officer notifies the Director
