# POLICY AND PROCEDURE

TITLE:	Dual Degree

# **POLICY STATEMENT:**

Goodwin University understands the complex academic goals our students may have. In accordance with our mission of assisting students to explore their academic options and qualify for a variety of career opportunities the University offers the opportunity to earn dual degrees. The Dual Degree enables a student to pursue two degrees at different levels concurrently or return to Goodwin post-graduation to earn a second degree in another major at the same level.

## PROCEDURE DETAILS:

### **DEFINITIONS:**

Concurrent dual degree – matriculation into two degree programs at different academic levels (e.g. Bachelor and Associate). Separate dual degree – graduation from one-degree program and then matriculation into a second degree program at the same (Associate and Associate or Bachelor and Bachelor) or different levels where there is at least a full-year of study beyond the first degree to earn the second (a minimum of 30 unique credits). Double major – (1.) the concurrent matriculation into two degree programs at the same academic level (e.g. Associate and Associate or Bachelor and Bachelor) or (2.) the graduation from one-degree program and then matriculation into a second degree program at the same or different level where there is less than a full-year of study beyond the first degree to earn the second (a minimum of 30 unique credits).
