POLICY STATEMENT

The Provost and Dean of Faculty may confer the title of Emeritus upon any retiring professor (after a minimum of twenty years of full-time service) who has given honorable and distinguished service to the University. The title will follow the regular professional title. For example, an Associate Professor of Health Science, Emeritus

PROCEDURE DETAILS

A faculty member who has served the University with distinction over a period of twenty or more years may be awarded the title of Emerita or Emeritus (also referred to as Emeritus faculty) upon retirement. A petition for exceptional circumstances may be submitted to the Faculty Senate for faculty members who have served the University with distinction for less than 20 years.
